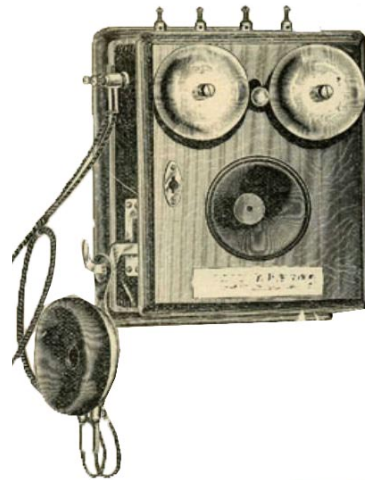
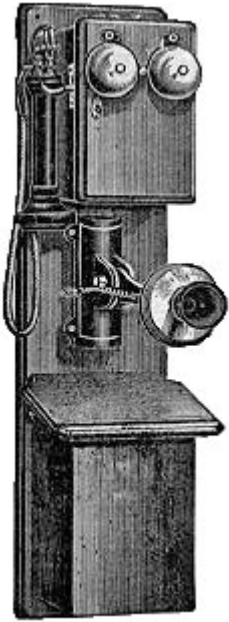

REMARKS The original company (J H Bunnell) was formed by Jesse H Bunnell in 1878  
to produce telegraphic equipment. He died in 1899 and his widow formed a competing  
company of Bunnell Telegraphic & Elec Co with the inherited patents after Jesse's partner,  
Charles McLaughlin, reincorporated the J H Bunnell Co. The two companies competed  
with each other producing the same telegraphic and electric devices. Within two years  
of its founding, Bunnell Telegraphic bought the J H Bunnell company and kept the  
original name. While known as a telegraphic mfg co, they also produced telephones for  
several years.

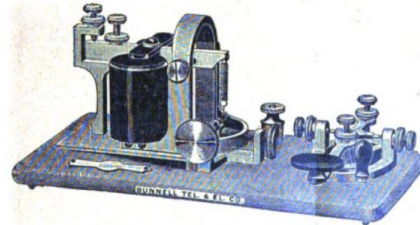
