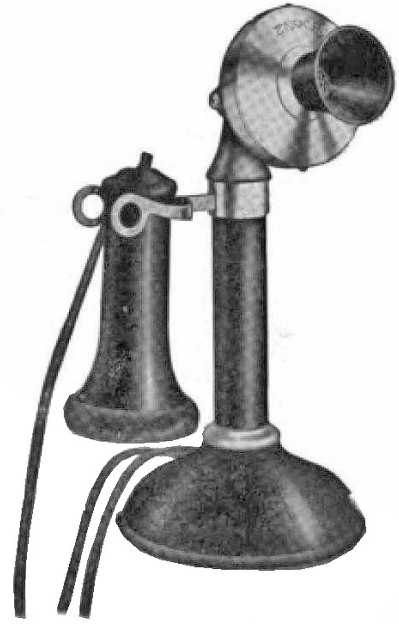

REMARKS Claude Enochs had over 10 years of telephony experience before organizing the company. He had patents on both a transmitter and receiver as well as other electrical parts. He strongly promoted a DC receiver which operated without an induction coil and utilized two opposing sets of coils and was connected in series with the transmitter. Their transmitter is known to have been labeled with their name.
