REMARKS It could be argued that Federal was formed in 1900 since Century Telephone was founded

at that time and Federal bought them in 1909. In 1918 Federal sold its telephone exchange business

to New York Telephone. Federal ceased to produce telephones and intercoms in the spring of 1929.

Federal produced radios in the 1920's but went into receivership during the summer of 1929.
