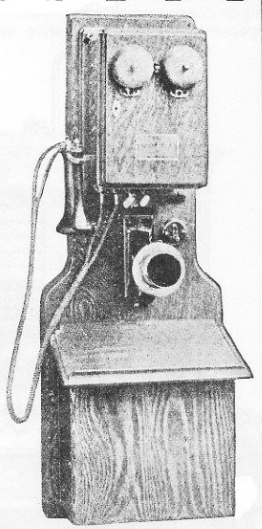

No. 45. BRIDGING.

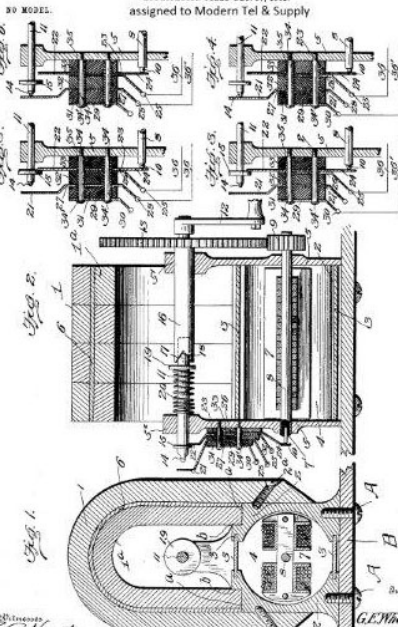

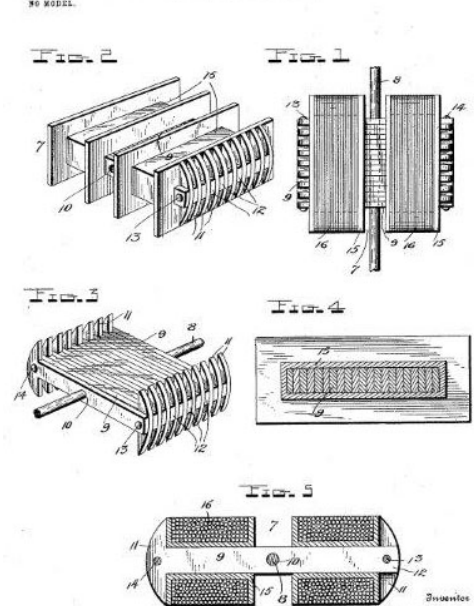
