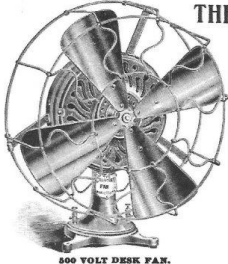

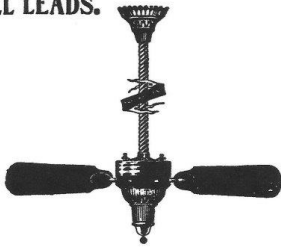


500 VOLT DESK FAN.

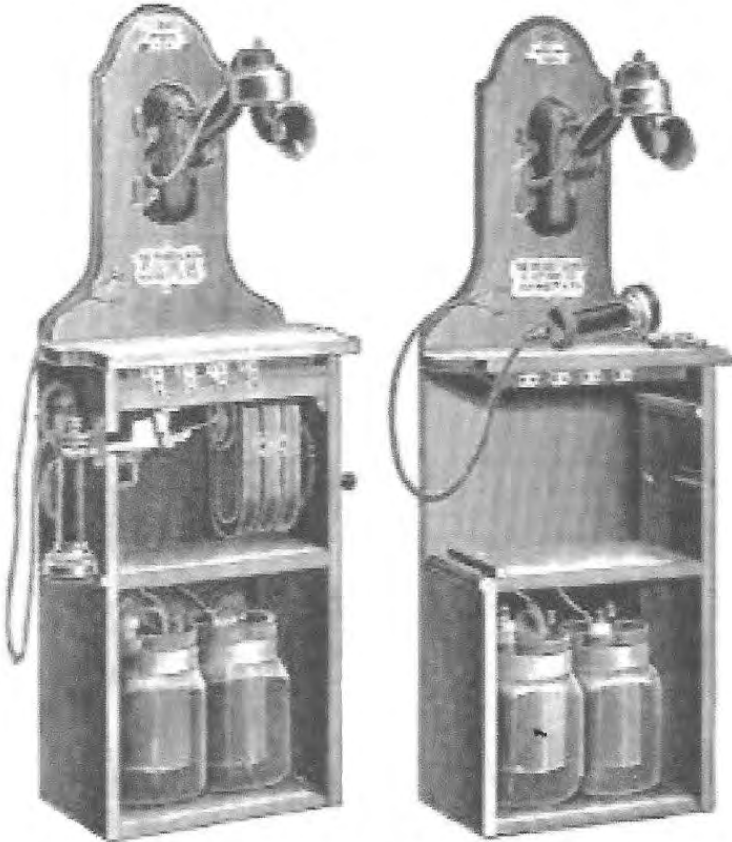

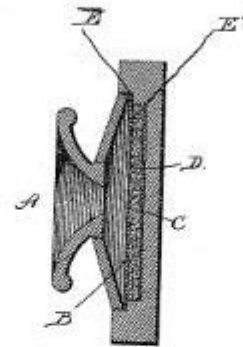
