REMARKS Sun Electric only lasted a year in operation. The cost of building their factory had been more costly than expected. By 1902 they were five thousand dollars in debt, could not pay their creditors and failed to pay their taxes.

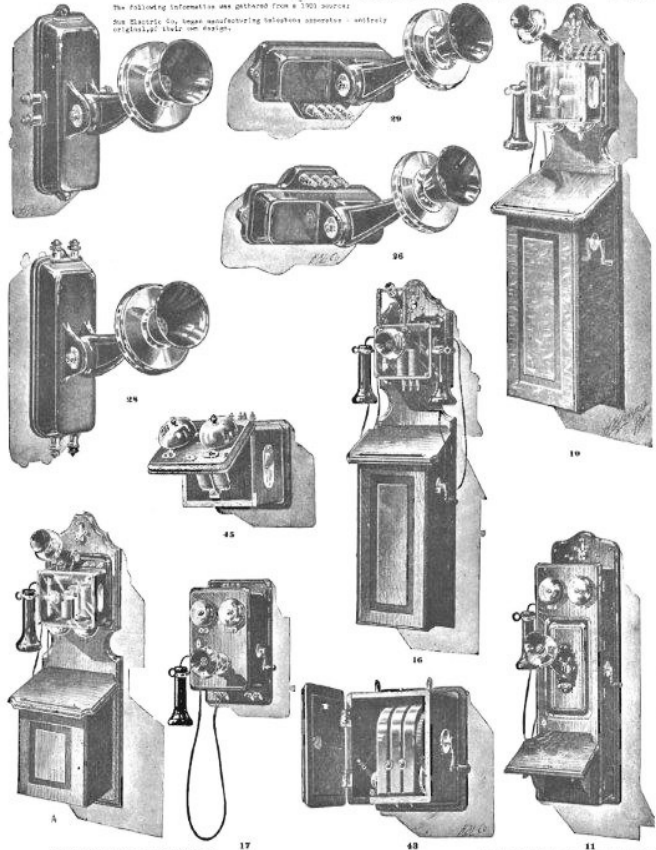

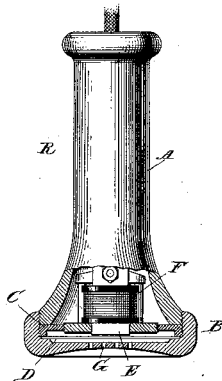
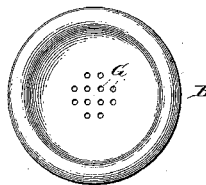
