REMARKS Suttle formed the company re-manufacturing telephones out of recycled parts. In 1939 the company developed a telephone called the Crystopac, a wooden desk and wall telephone for the independent market. They continued to re-manufacture phones such as Leich, Stomberg and Kellogg from recycled used phones.
