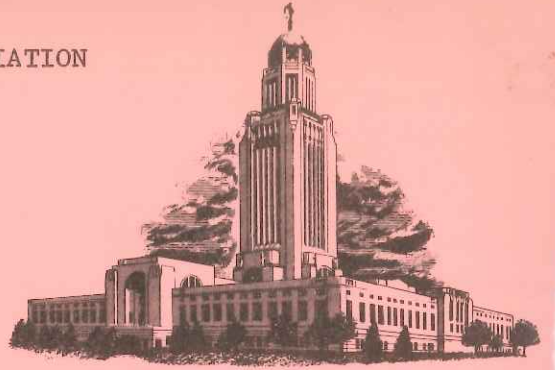

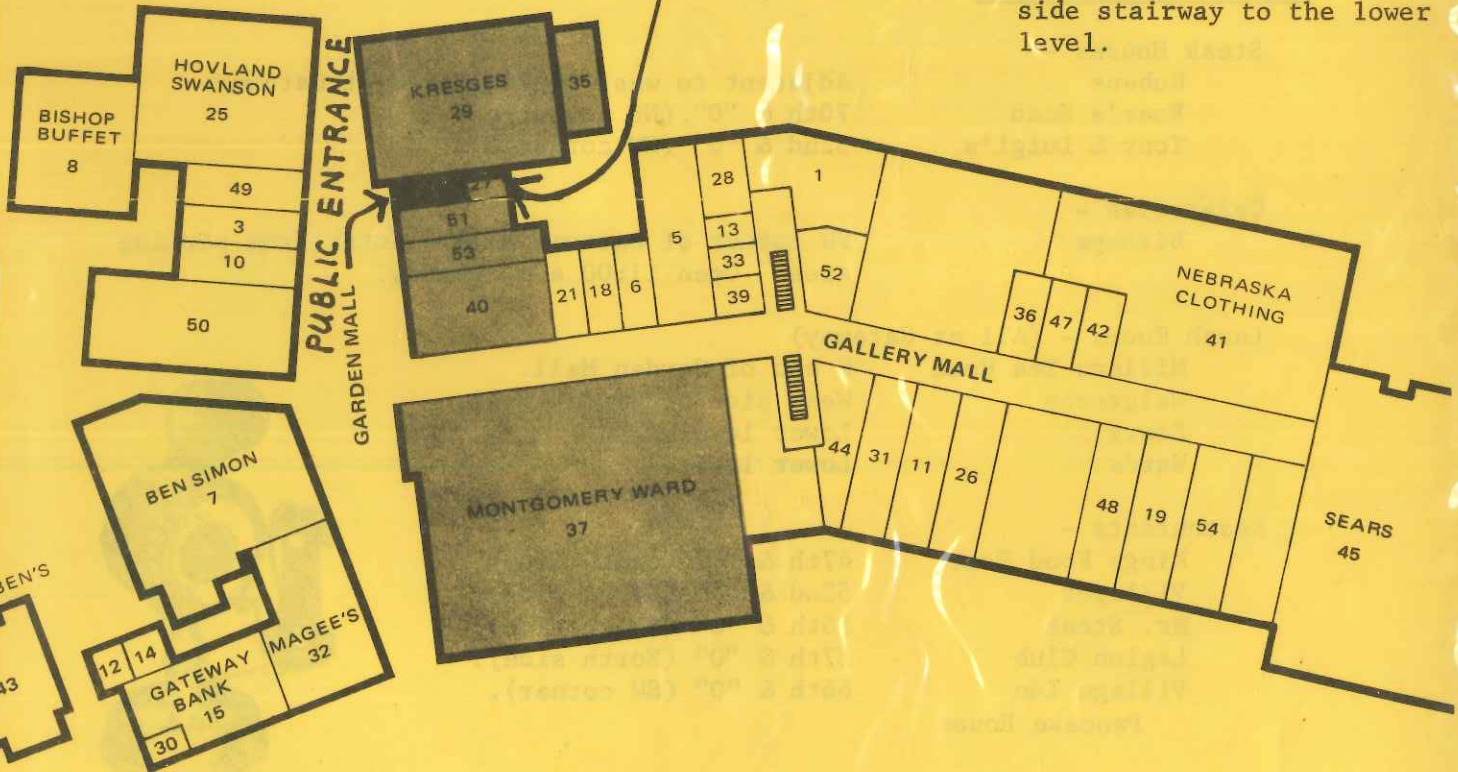
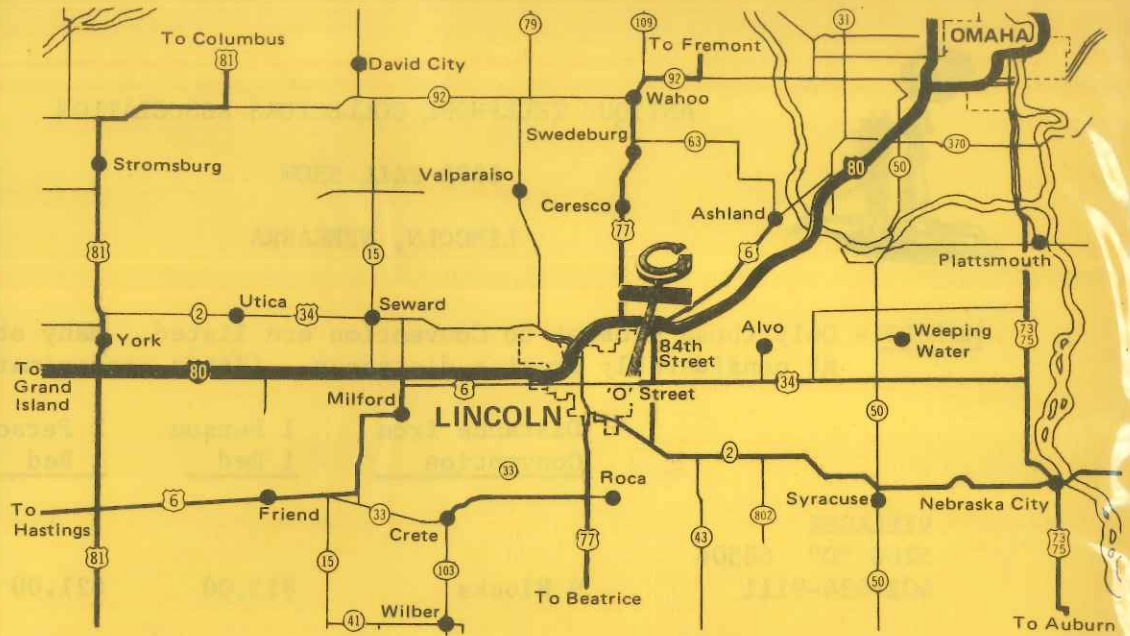

## **Antique Show Will Feature Old Telephones**

The Antique Telephone Collectors Assn. will hold its 1973 fall show at the Gateway Shopping Center Auditorium Oct. 6. The show will be open to the public from noon to 5:30.

Al Farmer, chairman of the event, said several hundred telephones are expected to be on display, including a replica of Alexander Graham Bell's first telephone, and the Frank H. Woods Telephone Pioneer Assn's collection of antique phones.

Farmer said the public is welcome to bring antique telephone equipment to the show for identification and appraisal.
